Tours typically pass the Basilica of the Assumption, The World Peace Bell*, Newport Aquarium, Hofbrauhaus, MainStrasse Village, the Krohn Conservatory, Cincinnati Art Museum, Ohio River Overlook*, Verdin Bell Museum, Fountain Square, the Taft/Longworth Museum, Lytle Park*, Great American Ball Park, Paul Brown Stadium and the Freedom Center. During your journey you’ll also get to taste two of the most popular hometown favorites, **Skyline Cheese Cones** and **Graeter’s Ice Cream**.

You will also visit Newport, KY’s newest state-of-the-art distillery for bourbon, the **Riff Distillery***. You will see the production and will learn about the different bourbons made in Kentucky.
